Clip 'n' Save: Deciphering Your MICR Line -Your Routing & Account Number

We often get questions from members when they need to fill out a form that asks for their financial institution's routing number and their account number. You may encounter this when requesting a wire transfer, filling out an automatic payment form for utilities, or even your PFD application. Below is an image that represents the bottom of a personal check. The numbers read from left to right and is called the MICR line, and it contains the information needed to identify your credit union and your full account number. Save this with your financial information in case you need to reference it in the future!
